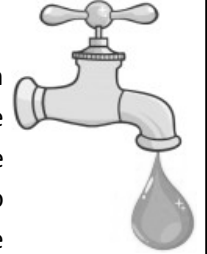
2017 Property Taxes

Tax notices will be mailed out around the last week of May. Taxes are due by July 4th, 4:30 pm. After July 4, 2017 any unpaid taxes are subject to a 10% late penalty, as mandated by the Province. For those paying via bank transfer, your payment must be sent far enough in advance to ensure the deposit is received by the Village on or before July 4th, 2017.

BE WATER WISE!

The goal of water conservation measures is to achieve more efficient water use. There are many good reasons to conserve water. Some economic considerations include: reducing the demand on our limited treatment and storage system; deferring infrastructure replacement costs; and reducing operational costs associated with supplying and distributing potable water and with the collection and treatment of wastewater. Here are some tips to help conserve water:



- Turn the tap off while brushing your teeth.
- Fill sink with water for rinsing dishes or vegetables.
- Run the dishwasher and the washing machine only when you have FULL loads.
- Keep some water in the fridge rather than running the tap to get a cold drink of water.
