

"Purple Air" Air Monitor

The Bulkley Valley – Lakes District Airshed Management Society and the Village of Telkwa have partnered on a new air quality monitoring station. The "Purple Air" air monitor is located at



the intersection of Hwy 16 and Hankin Ave. in front of the Village Office, and went "live" October 10, 2017.

This air monitor is an inexpensive, high quality particulate air pollution monitor which detects Particulate Matter 2.5 (PM 2.5). The monitor will deliver "real time" data available for all residents to review online at http://telkwa.cleanairplan.ca/
