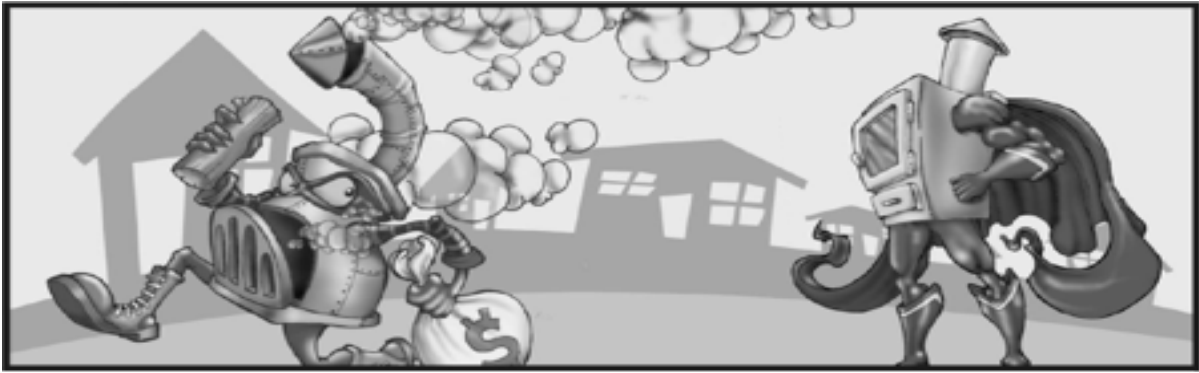


## 2018 Wood Stove Exchange Program



There's up to **\$1900.00** waiting for you as a incentive to recycle non-certified wood burning appliances and replace them with certified EPA appliances or some other more efficient heat source.

Live in the Bulkley Valley Lakes District Airshed?  
You qualify for \$250 or \$400

- 1) \$250 for the replacement of an uncertified wood burning stove with a qualifying EPA or CSA certified replacement or an uncertified wood furnace with an EPA or CSA certified wood furnace.
- 2) \$400 for the change-outs to a cleaner burning appliance such a pellet stove, an electric heat pump, or a gas or propane stove.

Live in the Town of Smithers?

You qualify for \$250 or \$400 plus either \$750 or \$1500!

- 1) \$750 if the wood burning appliance is a secondary source of heat for your home or shop and is listed below.
- 2) \$1500 if the wood burning appliance is a primary heat source in your residence and listed below.

We also have a few conditions:

- 1) residents live within the Town of Smithers boundaries for the additional rebate
- 2) there is still money available for each rebate type (first come, first serve)
- 3) old appliances are recycled or decommissioned and proof provided
- 4) cleaner burning appliances such a pellet stove, an electric heat pump, or a gas or propane stove or EPA certified wood appliances are installed and proof provided
- 5) if wood is your primary heat source we also need proof of this

Proof is simple - a signature from your dealer and/or recycler, a copy of your home insurance heating clause will also suffice.

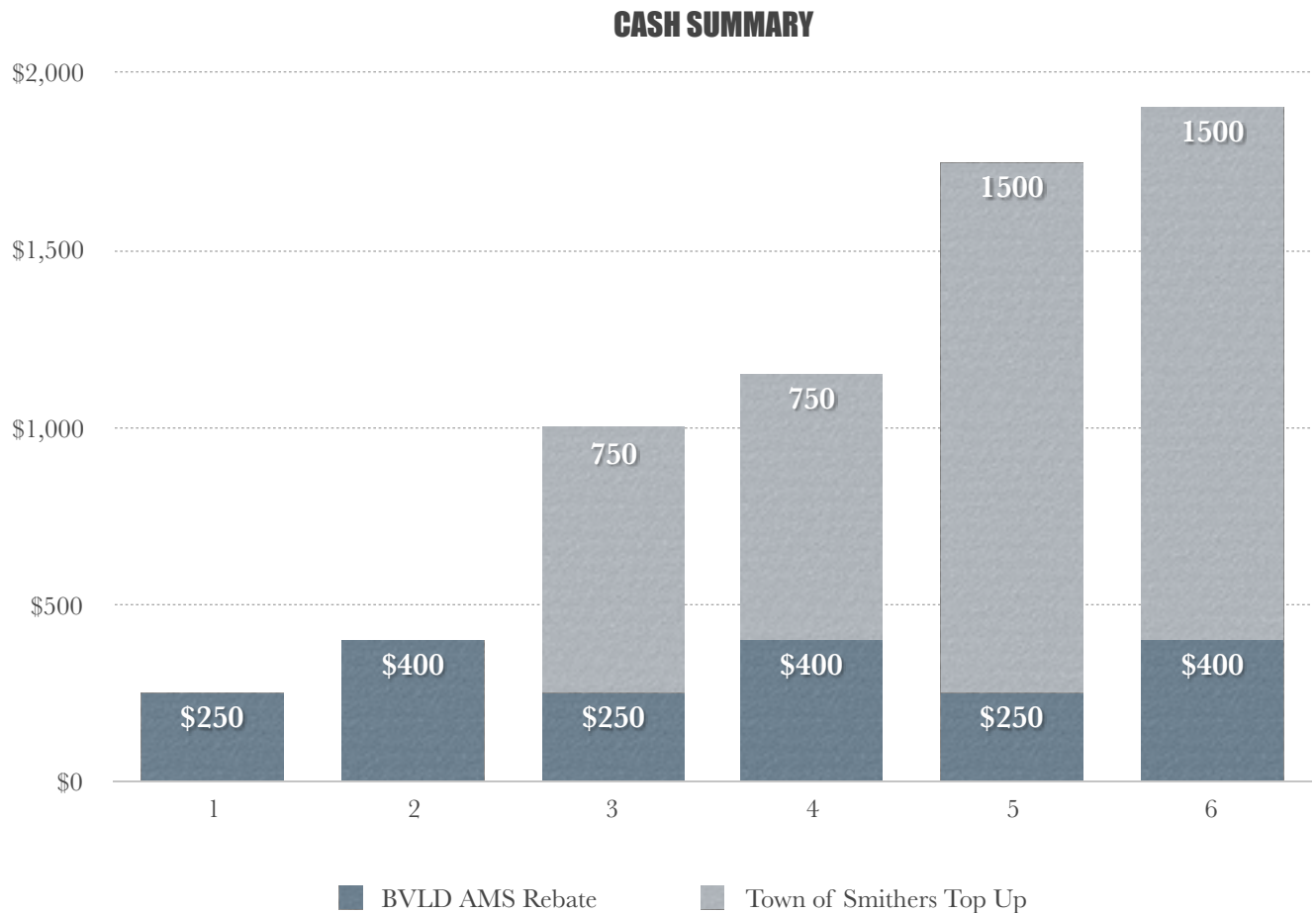
### **APPLIANCES in residences or shops in that can be changed out under this program include:**

- A free-standing non-EPA certified “stove”. A “homemade” or ‘barrel’ stove.
- A so-called “airtight” non-EPA certified fireplace insert, or tube type heat exchanger with a face plate and door (like the ‘Free Heat Machine’ or Welenco) that is currently installed in an open-hearth fireplace.
- A non-EPA certified “wood furnace” (ducted, forced air, home heating appliance) - may only be replaced by an EPA certified wood furnace or Pellet furnace.
- A wood-burning Cook Stove.
- In select cases other smoky appliances.

### **Qualifying Products to Replace Original Appliances**

- 1 An EPA-certified wood stove or pellet stove or an Enerchoice designated natural gas or propane fuelled stove or fireplace
- 2 An EPA-certified wood insert or pellet insert, an Enerchoice designated natural gas or propane fuelled insert, or an electric insert.
- 3 An EPA-certified factory-built wood fireplace

- This may only be accepted if it is replacing a non-EPA-certified wood stove or non-EPA-certified wood insert and not an existing factory-built fireplace
- 4 An electric heat pump that meets the criteria for BC Hydro's [heat pump rebate](https://www.bchydro.com/powersmart/residential/savings-and-rebates/current-rebates-buy-backs/home-renovation-rebates/rebates.html) (hyperlink to <https://www.bchydro.com/powersmart/residential/savings-and-rebates/current-rebates-buy-backs/home-renovation-rebates/rebates.html>) or the criteria for the Oil to Heat Pump Incentive (hyperlink to <http://oiltoheatpump.ca/>).
  - 5 An EPA or CSA B415 certified wood or pellet furnace ONLY if it is replacing an existing uncertified wood-burning furnace.

Now what?

2. Resident pays retail price for stove and installation. (Ask about manufacturer or retailer discount at the point of sale).
3. Resident arranges disposal of old stove to dealer or recycler for decommissioning. (Dealer may be able to arrange this for you).
4. Resident then gets signatures to confirm old is out and new is in.

6. We will determine your rebate qualifications cut one or two checks and mail them to you.
