

Garbage Collection:

The Village provides collection of garbage weekly as a service to our residents. Garbage carts can be purchased from the Village office and are required for collection.

- All garbage must be placed curbside in the appropriate cart by 8:00 a.m. to be collected. The truck is unable to return to collect late items.
- All loose garbage must be bagged in the cart, including cat litter and food waste.
- Do not place ashes in your garbage.
- Filling your cart too full may result in damage during collection.
- If you have additional garbage for collection, you must purchase an Excess Waste Tag from the Village Office and affix it to the bag. It is recommended that excess garbage be placed in a can with a secure fitting lid to keep dogs, birds, and other wildlife out of it. You may place a maximum of two Excess Waste items curbside.

Recycling Collection:

The Village of Telkwa (the Village) provides collection of recycling bi-weekly as a service to our residents. Recycling carts can be purchased from the Village office and are required for collection.

- All recyclable materials must be placed curbside in the appropriate cart by 7:00 a.m. to be collected. The truck is unable to return to collect late items.
- Filling your cart too full may result in damage during collection.
- Recycling collection is limited to one can; however, if you have exceeded the capacity of your cart, residents may bring their additional recycling to the Smithers Telkwa Transfer Station.
- Do not place your recycling in a plastic recycling bag as it will not be collected.
- Place shredded paper in a cardboard box or paper bag into the recycling bin.
- Cardboard boxes can be flattened and bundled together for collection.
- Ensure that all food residue is rinsed from containers prior to recycling.

Glass, plastic bags/overwrap, and styrofoam are not accepted curbside.






