PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

Neither the granting of a permit nor the approval of the drawings and specifications nor inspections made shall in any way relieve the owner of such building from full responsibility for carrying out the work or having the work carried out in accordance with the requirements of Municipal Bylaws and/or Provincial laws regulating building.

Any owner of property for which a permit is issued shall be responsible for the cost of repair of any damage to municipal works that occurs as a result of the work covered by the permit.

A permit is issued upon the condition that from the date the permit is issued:

- a) the work is to be started within six months;
- b) the work is not to be discontinued or suspended for a period of more than one year;
- c) the work, once commenced, is completed within two years.

The applicant shall, where required by the Building Inspector, include copies in duplicate of the Drawings and Specifications of the building with respect to which the work is to be carried out.

I hereby agree to indemnify and keep harmless the Village of Telkwa and its employees against all claims, liabilities, judgements, costs and expenses of whatsoever kind which may in any way occur against the said Village and its employees in consequence of and incidental to the granting of the permit, if issued, and I further agree to conform to all requirements of the Building Bylaws in force in the Village of Telkwa.
